## Looking forward to the IAF World Athletics Gala

On Friday 21 November 2014, the prestigious annual **World Athletics Gala** will be hosted in the **Le Chapiteau de l'Espace Fontvieille** by International Athletics Foundation (IAF) Honorary President HSH Prince Albert II of Monaco and IAF & IAAF President Lamine Diack.

The highlight of the evening will of course be the announcement of the 2014 male and female World Athletes of the Year, with the winners being presented with their trophies live on stage.

The Gala, which will be attended by a glittering array of present and former champions, will also give the global athletics family the opportunity to honour other outstanding achievements within the sport via further awards including the latest induction into the **IAAF Hall of Fame**.

In the week leading up to the Gala, the IAAF Council will meet for its autumn session during which among many important discussions and decisions, the host city of the 2019 IAAF World Championships will be decided.

November also marks the beginning of the **2014/2015 IAAF Cross Country Permit season**, which will kick off on Sunday 16 November in Burgos, Spain.


